




ACING THE PI ROUND


FACULTY DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP ON CASE STUDY WRITING





DEBATE COMPETITION TO CELEBRATE HINDI DIWAS




'MIND YOUR MIND: A MEDITATION AND YOGA WORKSHOP'







The Rise of AI-Powered Code Generation: Can AI Replace Programmers?

AI tools like GitHub Copilot and OpenAl Codex are changing the way we write code, making it faster and easier. As a BCA first-year student, I've found these tools to be really helpful in speeding up my coding tasks, like generating code and fixing simple errors. For example, GitHub Copilot has been shown to increase productivity by up to 55%. But even though these tools are powerful, I don't think they can ever fully replace human programmers.

Al can do a lot of repetitive work, saving us time and reducing mistakes. It can automatically write basic code and suggest fixes, which is great for beginners like me. However, AI doesn't have the creativity or critical thinking that we bring to programming. While AI might be able to suggest code, it doesn't understand the bigger picture, like the goals of a project or the needs of the user. It can also miss important things like security risks or ethical issues, areas where human programmers are needed to make sure everything is safe and fair.

Al is helpful for automating simple tasks, like finding bugs or suggesting code completions but won't replace programmers. Instead, it will give us more time to focus on creative and complex tasks like designing software systems or solving problems that AI just can't handle.

As a BCA first-year student, I see AI tools as a big help in learning to code faster and making

fewer mistakes. But even with all these advantages, AI will never replace the creativity and problem- solving skills that we, as human programmers, bring to the table. AI might help me write code, but it can't replace the thought process and ideas I bring to building a project.

In conclusion, AI tools are great for making programming easier, but they won't take over the job of human programmers. They help with the repetitive parts of coding, leaving us with more time to focus on the creative and important aspects of building software. For students like me, AI tools are an amazing tool to learn and grow, but human skills will always be essential in programming.


Beyond The Classroom: The Bright Places of College Life
